

The Autumn meeting of the British Society of Rhinoplasty Surgeons will be held at the Park House in Cardiff, on 14th November 2016. Arguably the most important 19th century house in Wales, the Park House was designed by the Gothic revivalist architect Williams Burges for the Marquess of Bute and is a Grade 1 listed building. The meeting will have exclusive use of the building for the day.

Centrally located, and close to the impressive Cardiff Civic Centre, the Park House is a 20 minute walk from Cardiff Central Railway Station, although taxis are easily available. Within a 5 minute walk, there are a number of hotels and an NCP car park.
